CASE STUDY



The Erie Department of Health and the Northwest Pennsylvania (NWP) Tobacco Control Program partnered with HPW Associates to create a protocol to be used by all housing providers in helping advance this initiative to make multi-unit housing become smoke-free.

Based on existing information and interviews with both national leaders and local providers, *HPW Associates developed a step-by-step protocol (with available resources) to assist NWP coalition providers in their work with both owners/managers of HUD and private multi-unit housing complexes in putting into place a smoke-free policy. Service providers were trained, activities and outcomes were tracked, and the protocol remains in use.*
